• We take care of the sculpture of Lincoln in the Gettysburg Square. Sculptor Seward Johnson's "Return Visit" was commissioned by the Fellowship, and dedicated in 1991.
• We educate students by helping fund Gettysburg National Military Park's Lincoln Trunk program that sends educational materials to schools.
